

## RULING OF THE COURT

1. Mr. Stephen Agaba, Counsel for the Respondent, at the hearing of the Application dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2015 and filed on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2015 raised an objection to any reference by the Applicant to certain annexures to the Applicant's Supplementary Affidavit sworn on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 and filed on the same day.
2. It is his simple submission that these annexures, having been obtained without leave of the East African Legislative Assembly (EALA) have been filed contrary to S.20 of the EALA (Powers and Privileges) Act 2003.
3. Mr. Tumwebaze for the Applicant left the matter to the Court's discretion.
4. Our view is that since the annexures are already on the record, let the Respondent make any objections to the admissibility of the said annexures as part of his submissions on the Application before us and we shall determine the same as we determine the Application in its entirety.
5. In the event, the hearing of the Application shall continue along those lines.
6. Orders accordingly.
